





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Joining underbar units together...

...via bottom mounting plate.

- 1) Align units side-by-side as desired (figure 1).
- 2) Adjust height of feet using adjustable feet until units are level.
- 3) With the drive screws, screw the bottom mounting clip to the leg channels (*figure 2*).
- 4) Screw the bolts through the clip and leg channels, and apply the nut as shown in *figure 3*.

...via back plate.

- 1) Align units side-by-side as desired (*figure 4*). A clamp can be used to pull the units together, if necessary.
- Adjust height of feet using adjustable feet until units are level.
- 3) With the drive screws, screw the plate and the side panel return flanges together (*figure 5*).
